

Become a Writing Center Tutor

How do I qualify?

For undergraduate students:

- Complete ENGL 1010 or equivalent
- Complete ENGL 2010 (if you are currently enrolled, you may apply with a professor recommendation)
- Have advanced skills and applied knowledge in reading and writing

For graduate students:

- Be a graduate instructor in the English Department
- Have advanced skills and applied knowledge in reading and writing

What are the responsibilities of a tutor?

- Complete ENGL 4910 (undergraduate) or ENGL 6820 (graduate) in your first semester of tutoring
- Observe at least four tutoring sessions within your first four weeks as a tutor
- Be observed by a director while tutoring and review goals afterwards
- Be subject to evaluation by students
- Attend monthly staff meetings
- Follow guidelines in *The Bedford Guide for Writing Tutors* and *The USU Writing Center Handbook of Policies and Procedures*

How do I apply?

For undergraduate students:

- Apply on CareerAggie around the end of the semester
- Include resume, three references, a list of your USU English professors, and a writing sample

For graduate students:

- Apply through the English Department
